

Proceeds of crime

The Commission's 1991 Report on [Confiscation of the Proceeds of Crime](#) (LRC 35 – 1991) recommended the introduction of legislation to allow the confiscation of the proceeds of crime. It also included recommendations on international co-operation. In the aftermath of the killing of the journalist Veronica Guerin in 1996, the Oireachtas passed the *Proceeds of Crime Act 1996*, based on the Commission's recommendations, and established the Criminal Assets Bureau (CAB).
