WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of the 31st ultimo, a violent attack was made by an armed Party of Men on the House of John M'Ternan, in the Mountain part of Coolcolly, Parish of Kilbarn, within a Mile and a half of Ballyshannon, and County of Donegal, in which the said M'Ternan was ill-used, and the House and Furniture injured.

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

FORTY POUNDS

to any Person or Persons who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as will lead to the apprehension and conviction of all or any of them.
