WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of Saturday, the 11th of April instant, some Persons unknown, maliciously cut off the Tails and Ears of Two Bullocks, and killed a Cow, the Property of Mr. Donaldson, by stabbing her, on the Lands of Tullyvalien, Barony of Upper Fews, County of Armagh:

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

FIFTY POUNDS

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who were the principals therein,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned therein.
