WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of Sunday the 29th of July ultimo, some Persons unknown, fired through the Windows of the House of Patrick Gill, who resides on the Town-land of Kellycomaine, in the County of Armagh, and severely wounded him.

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

THREE HUNDRED POUNDS

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who actually fired the Shots,) who shall within Six Months from the date hereof, give such information as may lead to the Apprehension and Conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in this Outrage.
