TWENTY POUNDS

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who actually struck Mrs. Pender, or her Son,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned therein.
