WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of Saturday, the 12th of May instant, an armed Party attacked the Houses of several Farmers in the Parish of Larah, in the County of Cavan, and have committed various Outrages in the surrounding Parishes.

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to justice the Perpetrators of

these Outrages, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

ONE HUNDRED POUNDS,

to any Person or Persons, who shall within Six Months from the date hereof, give such information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in these daring Outrages.

And further, His Excellency is pleased hereby to declare, that if any of the Persons concerned in these Outrages, shall deliver up their accomplices, so that all, or any of them, may be convicted thereof, he or they shall receive His Majesty's Most Gracious Pardon, as well as the said Reward.
