WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that as Edward Synge, Esq. accompanied by his Servant, was riding near Applevale, not far from Corrofin, in the County of Clare, on Wednesday, the 16th of February instant, he was fired at by four Persons unknown, and that one of the shots took effect, wounding the Servant so severely that his life is despaired of, and that Mr. Synge also received two wounds.

His Excellency for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who actually fired the shots,) who shall within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in this daring Outrage.
