WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the 30th day of July last, as Mr. Lucas was on his way to Mitchelstown, he was fired at on the Mail-Coach road, about three miles and a-half from Fermoy, and several slugs passed through his clothes.

Now We, the Lord Lieutenant, for the better apprehending and bringing to justice the Person or Persons concerned in the above Outrage, are pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

ONE HUNDRED POUNDS,

to any Person or Persons concerned in said Outrage, (except the Person or Persons who fired the shot,) who shall within Six Months from the date hereof, give such information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of the Party concerned.
