Sunday, the 7th of August instant, a Person of the name of John O'Neil, of the Parish of Magherafelt, was Murdered on Glenshane Mountain, in the Barony of Remraught, in the County of Londonderry.

His Excellency for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice, the Perpetrators of this Murder, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

**ONE HUNDRED POUNDS,**

to any Person or Persons, (except the Person or Persons who actually committed the Murder) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in this daring Outrage.
