

# ONE HUNDRED POUNDS REWARD.

*Dublin Castle, 1<sup>st</sup> October, 1821.*

**T**HE Lord Lieutenant for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in the Murder of Daniel Farrell, near Aughnacloy, on the 16th of August last, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of One Hundred Pounds for the Discovery and Conviction of the Persons who committed said Murder; and also to promise His Majesty's Pardon to any of the Persons concerned therein, (excepting the Person or Persons who actually committed the same) in addition to the Reward of One Hundred Pounds above-mentioned, who shall, within Six Months from this Date, discover their Accomplices, so as that they, or any of them, be convicted of the said Murder.
