

Dublin Castle, November 17, 1824.

WHEREAS it hath been represented unto the Lord Lieutenant, that Timothy Carty, Michael Carroll, John Murphy, John Butler, and James Kinsella, who are employed by the Dublin Gas Light Company were, as they were quitting their work at Ten o'Clock on the Night of Friday the 12th instant, attacked by a number of Persons unknown to them, armed with sticks, who suddenly assaulted them near the Gas Works at the North Lotts, and that Timothy Carty, Michael Carroll, and John Murphy, were knocked down and inhumanly beaten, and are so dangerously wounded as to make their recovery doubtful.

The Lord Lieutenant for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in the Outrage above-mentioned, is hereby pleased to offer a Reward of

ONE HUNDRED POUNDS,

and also His Majesty's Pardon, to any one of them (except the Persons who actually wounded the said Timothy Carty, Michael Carroll, and John Murphy,) who shall within Six Months from the Date hereof, discover his Accomplices therein, so as that they, or any of them, may be apprehended and convicted thereof.
