WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of the 5th of May instant, an armed Party entered the House of John Connor, of Lahoo, in the Parish of Kilbohané, in the County of Kerry, and having fired several Shots; robbed him of Money :
