WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on Sunday, the 9th day of September instant, the Rev. — Mandeville, while on his road to do duty at the Church of Killbeacon, was attacked near Mullinavat, County Kilkenny, and beaten with Stones.

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

ONE HUNDRED POUNDS,

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who actually flung the Stones,) who shall within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in this Outrage.
