

DUBLIN CASTLE,

May 30, 1833.

WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that as Mr. James Body, of Killanchey, in the County of Leitrim, was returning from the Fair of Drumlesh, in the County of Longford, on the Evening of the 14th instant, on passing the bridge which divides the two Counties, two shots were fired at him, and two balls passed through his right side :

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

FIFTY POUNDS

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who fired at Mr. Body, as aforesaid,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned therein.
