His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of FIFTY POUNDS,

to any Person or Persons, (except the Person or Persons who were the leader or leaders in this Attack,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all or any of the Persons concerned in this Attack.
