**W**HEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Evening of Monday, the 29th of October ultimo, Thomas Maguirk, and John Maguirk, were violently assaulted at a place called the Chord, in the County of the Town of Drogheda, and severely beaten by a number of Persons.

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

**FIFTY POUNDS**

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who were leaders therein,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in this Outrage.
