WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that illegal Confederacies and Combinations have been entered into by divers ill-disposed persons in the baronies of Upper and Lower Dundalk, and adjoining districts, in the county of Louth, and that in consequence thereof, several serious Outrages have been committed upon persons and property in the said county:

His Excellency is pleased hereby to offer a reward of

ONE HUNDRED POUNDS

to any person or persons, who shall, within six months from the date hereof, give such information as shall lead to the CONVICTION of any person or persons engaged in any of the said illegal Combinations or Confederacies.
