

£515 19s. REWARD.

**W**HEREAS, the House of Mr. John Burka, of Becon, in the Parish of Becon, Barony of Costello, and County of Mayo, was set on Fire by the Hand of an Incendiary, and burned to the Ground, in open Day, on the 2d instant.

And whereas a valuable out Office into which, whatever had been saved from the Flames of the former Day had been stored, was set on Fire in like manner before Day-light, on the Morning of Wednesday the 9th instant, and every thing therein contained, together with a Horse and an Ass, were totally consumed.

Now We, whose Names are hereunto subscribed, in order to shew our detestation of this atrocious Crime, and our determination to use our utmost exertions to bring to Justice the Perpetrator or Perpetrators thereof, do promise to pay the Sums set opposite our Names, to Reward any Person or Persons who may prosecute such Criminals to Conviction, and to give proportionate to such Persons as may give such private Information to Magistrates or Chief Constables, as may lead to Conviction
