Party paraded through the Town of Newport, in the County of Mayo, and severely beat two Men named John Doherty and Jeremiah Bourke.

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

FORTY POUNDS,

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who were the leaders in this act,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in this Outrage.
