W HEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night Monday the 18th of June instant, the House of Patrick Duffy, at Kentstown in the county Meath, was attacked by an armed Party, one of whom fired a Shot through the door, which Killed the said Patrick Duffy:

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to justice the Perpetrators of this daring Outrage and Murder, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

TWO HUNDRED POUNDS

to any Person or Persons, who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Perpetrators of this Murder:

And further, His Excellency is pleased hereby to declare, that if any of the Persons concerned in this Murder, (except the Person who fired the shot,) who shall declare his accomplices, so that all, or any of them, may be arrested and convicted thereof, he shall receive His Majesty's Most Gracious Pardon, as well as the said Reward.
