

# DUBLIN CASTLE,

18th November, 1857.

**W**HEREAS it has been represented to the Lords Justices, that about the hour of Half-past Ten o'Clock on the morning of the 1st instant, as Mr. Richard Connell, of Robinstown, in the County of Meath, was returning home from Kilskyre Chapel, he was assaulted near that place by several persons at present unknown, and from the injuries then received has since died.

Their Excellencies, for the better apprehending and bringing to justice the perpetrators of this Homicide, are pleased hereby to offer a reward of

**ONE HUNDRED POUNDS**

to any person or persons, who shall, within six months from the date hereof, give such information as shall lead to the ARREST of the person or persons who committed the same.
