

DUBLIN CASTLE,

13th October, 1829.

WHEREAS, it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of the 23d September last, or early on the Morning of Thursday, the 24th of September, ultimo, an armed Party of about twenty in number, attacked the House of John Carney, of Gustavoher, about five miles from Gort, in the County of Roscommon, and about one mile from Tubber, in said County, who broke open his door, and dragged him by the hair of his head, and, placing him on his knees, presented their guns at him, and compelled him to swear that he would deliver up his House and Lands; and that one of the Party afterwards deliberately fired a gun at the said John Carney, while in bed, (leaning the gun over his Wife's shoulder,) the shot passing over his head.

His Grace, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in the above Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

ONE HUNDRED POUNDS,

to any Person or Persons, (except the Person who actually fired the shot), who shall within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of any, or all of the Persons concerned in the above-mentioned violent and daring Outrage.
