A PROCLAMATION.

WELLESLEY.

WHEREAS We have received Information, that on the Evening of the First Day of October instant, as the Three Brothers of Philip Mara, (who prosecuted Patrick Grace to Conviction at the last Assizes, for the Murder of Richard Chadwicke, Esq.) were returning Home from Work, they were Waylaid and Fired at near the Lands of Rathcannon, in the County of Tipperary, by several Persons at present unknown, with intent to Murder them, and that Daniel Mara, one of the said Brothers, having taken refuge in a Neighbouring House, the said Persons forcibly broke open the Door of the said House, and immediately Murdered the said Daniel Mara, by Shooting him.

Now We the Lord Lieutenant and Council, being determined, as far as in Us lies, to bring the Persons concerned in the said barbarous Murder, and every of them, to speedy and condign Punishment, do hereby Publish and Declare, that if any Person or Persons shall, within the Space of Six Calendar Months from the date hereof, discover the Persons concerned in the Murder of the said Daniel Mara, so as that they or any of them be Apprehended and Prosecuted to Conviction for the said Offence, such Person or Persons so Discovering, shall receive as a Reward, the Sum of

TWO THOUSAND POUNDS,

the same to be Paid in the following Manner, that is to say, the Sum of

FOUR HUNDRED POUNDS,

for each and every of the first Five Persons concerned in the said Murder, as Perpetrators or Accomplices, who shall be Apprehended and Prosecuted to Conviction as aforesaid.

And in Order to induce any of the Accomplices in the said Murder to make Discovery thereof, We do hereby offer His Majesty's most Gracious Pardon to any of the said Accomplices (except the Person or Persons who actually Fired at the said Daniel Mara), who shall give Information, so as that the others, or any of them, may be Apprehended and Prosecuted to Conviction, and so as said last-mentioned Discovery shall be made within the Space of Two Calendar Months from the Date hereof.

And We do hereby strictly Charge and Command all Mayors, Sheriffs, Bailiffs, and all others His Majesty's loving Subjects, to be Aiding and Assisting in Apprehending all and every of the Person or Persons who was, or were Concerned, in the aforesaid Murder, or in instigating the same, so as that he or they may be apprehended for the Same according to Law.
