WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that about the Hour of Twelve o'Clock on the Night of Sunday, the 9th of August instant, the House of Mathew Hayes, (on the Lands of Ballyanny, within three miles of the Town of Nenagh, in the Barony of Lower Ormond, County of Tipperary) was maliciously set on fire, and totally consumed by an armed Party.

His Grace, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of the above daring Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

to any Person or Persons who shall within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as may lead to the apprehension, and conviction of any, or all of the Offenders concerned in the above-mentioned Outrage.
