

## DUBLIN CASTLE

*December 29, 1835.*

**W**HEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of the 16th instant, Richard Long, Esq., of Longfield, in the Parish of Ardmoyle, and County of Tipperary, was fired at by Three Men, as he was returning from the Cashel Petty Sessions:

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of the above Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

**TWO HUNDRED POUNDS**

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who actually committed the same,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all or any of the Persons concerned therein.
