

FIFTY POUNDS REWARD.

Dublin Castle, 1st October, 1821.

THE Lord Lieutenant for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in the Murder of Patrick Murphy, near Caledon, on the 16th of August last, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of Fifty Pounds for the Discovery and Conviction of the Person or Persons who committed the said Murder; and also to promise His Majesty's Pardon to any of the Person or Persons concerned therein, (excepting the Person or Persons who actually committed the same) in addition to the Reward of Fifty Pounds above-mentioned, who shall, within Six Months from this Date, discover their Accomplices, so as that they, or any of them, be convicted of the said Murder.
