

DUBLIN CASTLE,

21st June, 1830.

WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of the 19th of May last, a Shot was fired through the Window of the Reverend Thomas Jervis White's Bedchamber, at the Hour of Twelve o'Clock, and two Bullets lodged therein:

His Grace, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in the above-mentioned Outrage, is pleased hereby to promise His Majesty's Pardon to any Person or Persons concerned in the aforesaid Outrage, (except the Person or Persons who fired the Shot,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, discover his accomplice or accomplices, so that they, or any of them may be convicted thereof.
