**W**HEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of the 10th of December instant, the House of a Man named Kennedy, of Ballynahineen, near Carrick-on-Suir, in the County of Waterford, was attacked, and he warned to quit his Farm; and that on the Night of the 22d of November ultimo, the House of Walter Power, of the said District of Ballynahineen, was also attacked, and he directed to give up his holding:

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to justice, the Perpetrators of these Outrages, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

**FIFTY POUNDS**

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who were leaders in these Attacks,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in any of these said Outrages.
