

DUBLIN CASTLE,

19th December, 1833.

WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Night of the 29th of November ultimo, the House of Richard Sheehan, of Ballenana, near Cappoquin, in the County of Waterford, was attacked, and he warned to quit the service of Mr. Charmley, of Salterbridge ; and that on the same Night the House of Joseph Marsh, Woodranger, at Salterbridge, was attacked, and he severely beaten ; and that on the Night of the 8th December instant, several Notices were posted in the same District, threatening the Steward of Mr. Charmley :

His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to justice the Perpetrators of these Outrages, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

FIFTY POUNDS

to any Person or Persons (except the Person or Persons who were the Principals therein,) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such Information as shall lead to the apprehension and conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in all, or any of these Attacks.
