WHEREAS it has been represented to the Lord Lieutenant, that on the Evening of Sunday, the 23d of January, ult., an armed Party attacked the House of a Person named Salmon, who resides at Kilpatrick, near the Post-Town of Mullingar, in the County of Westmeath, who broke into the House, and fired a shot, by which Anne Salmon was wounded.

His Excellency for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer His Majesty's promise of Pardon to any of the Persons concerned therein, (except the Person who fired the shot which wounded Anne Salmon) who shall within Six Months from the date hereof, declare his accomplices, so that all, or any of them may be apprehended and convicted thereof.
