His Excellency, for the better apprehending and bringing to Justice the Perpetrators of this Outrage, is pleased hereby to offer a Reward of

TWO HUNDRED POUNDS

to any Person or Persons (except the Persons who were actually engaged in this Murder) who shall, within Six Months from the date hereof, give such information as shall lead to the Apprehension and Conviction of all, or any of the Persons concerned in this cruel Murder.
