O RDERED, That the Lords Archbishops and Bishops now in town, or any Three or more of them, do prepare a Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving to Almighty God, for His late merciful preservation of the Queen from the atrocious and treasonable attempt against Her sacred person, on Wednesday, the 10th day of June instant; and that such Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving be used in all churches and chapels in Ireland, upon Sunday, the Twenty-first of this instant June, or so soon as the Ministers thereof shall receive the same, and to be continued for thirty days afterwards.

Given at the Council Chamber, in Dublin, the 18th day of June, 1840.
