

By the Lords Justices and Council of Ireland.

PLUNKET, C.

ORDERED, that the Lords Archbishops and Bishops now in Town, do prepare a Form of Thanksgiving to Almighty God for Her Majesty's safe delivery of a Princess; and that such Form of Thanksgiving be used in all Churches and Chapels in Ireland, upon Sunday, the twenty-ninth of this instant November, or the Sunday after the respective Ministers thereof shall receive the same:

And it is hereby further ordered, that Her Majesty's Printers do forthwith print a competent number of Copies of the said Form of Thanksgiving, that the same may be forthwith sent round and read in the several Churches and Chapels in Ireland.

the 27th day of November, 1840.
