RDERED, that the Lords Archbishops and Bishops now in Town, do prepare a Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving to Almighty God for His late merciful Preservation of the Queen from the atrocious and treasonable attempt against Her sacred Person, on Monday, the Thirtieth day of May last; and that such Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving be used in all Churches and Chapels in Ireland, upon Sunday, the Twelfth of this instant June, or so soon as the Ministers of such Churches or Chapels shall respectively receive the same; and be continued for Thirty Days afterwards:

And it is hereby further ordered, that Her Majesty's Printers do forthwith print a competent Number of Copies of the said Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving, in order that the same may be forthwith sent round and read in the several Churches and Chapels in Ireland.

Given at the Council Chamber in Dublin, the Eighth Day of June, 1842.
