RDERED, that the Lords Archbishops and Bishops, now in town, do prepare a Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving to Almighty God, for Her Majesty's safe delivery of a Princess; and that such Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving be used in all Churches and Chapels in Ireland, upon Sunday, the Second day of April next, or the Sunday after the respective Ministers of such Churches and Chapels shall receive the same:

And it is hereby further ordered, that Her Majesty's Printers do forthwith print a competent number of copies of the said Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving, that the same may be forthwith sent round, and read in the several Churches and Chapels in Ireland.
