RDERED, that His Grace the Archbishop of Armagh, do prepare a Form of Prayer to Almighty God, on account of the great mortality caused by the Cholera; and that such Form of Prayer be used in all Churches and Chapels in Ireland, on Sunday, the 23rd day of September instant, and be continued during the prevalence of the Cholera in this country:

And it is hereby further ordered, that Her Majesty's Printers do forthwith print a competent number of copies of the said Form of Prayer, in order that the same may be forthwith sent round, and read in the several Churches and Chapels in Ireland.
