CARLISLE.

ORDERED, that the Lords Archbishops and Bishops now in Town do prepare a Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving to Almighty God for the signal and repeated Successes obtained by the Troops of Her Majesty and by those of Her Allies in the Crimea, and especially for the Capture of the Town of Sebastopol; and that such Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving be used in all Churches and Chapels in Ireland, upon Sunday, the Seventh day of October instant.

And it is hereby further Ordered, that Her Majesty's Printers do forthwith print a competent number of copies of the said Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving, in order that the same may be forthwith sent round and read in the several Churches and Chapels in Ireland.
