JOSEPH NAPIER, C. SEATON.

ORDERED, that the Lords Archbishops and Bishops now in Town do prepare a Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving to Almighty God for the constant and signal Successes obtained by the Troops of Her Majesty and by the whole of the Forces serving in India, whereby the late sanguinary Mutiny and Rebellion which had broken out in that Country hath been effectually suppressed, and the blessings of Tranquillity, Order, and Peace, are restored to Her Majesty's subjects in the East, and that such Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving be used in all Churches and Chapels in Ireland on Sunday the First day of May next.

And it is hereby further Ordered, that Her Majesty's Printers do forthwith print a competent number of copies of the said Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving, in order that the same may be forthwith sent round and read in the several

Churches and Chapels in Ireland.
