

Dublin Castle, 1st December, 1821.

HIS Excellency the Lord Lieutenant hereby directs and requires, that all the Out-Pensioners of Chelsea Hospital, and all those Men ^{Men} who are registered in the Books of Chelsea Hospital, with a view to prospective Pension; and also all Out-Pensioners and registered Men of Kilmainham Hospital, residing in Ireland, who were discharged from their respective Corps, as Non-commissioned Officers or Privates, whether from the Regular Cavalry, Foot Guards, or Infantry of the Line, or from the Militia or Fencibles, do personally appear at the Places hereafter mentioned, on Thursday the 6th Day of December, or on any of the succeeding Days, until the 12th of the same Month inclusive, in order that such of them as on examination shall be found fit, may be attached to such Corps as shall be hereafter appointed. His Excellency, however, directs, that the present Order shall not be considered as extending to the Out-Pensioners from the late Horse Guards, and Horse Grenadier Guards, the Life Guards, and Royal Regiment of Horse Guards, nor to such Men as by the Hospital Books are now more than forty-five years of age, or had served twenty-four years in the Cavalry, or twenty-one years in the Infantry, previous to their discharges; nor to any Men discharged as Privates, whose Pensions are above ten pence per Diem each; nor to those who have lost a limb, or their eye-sight, or are cripples, or who received a Certificate of their unsuitness for further Service, from any of the Officers employed at the last General Examination of Out-Pensioners of Chelsea and Kilmainham respectively; nor to such Out-Pensioners as are now serving in the Regular Militia, as non-commissioned Officers, or in the Police Establishments of the City of Dublin, or of the respective Counties in which that description of protection is main-

tailed under the Provisions of the Peace Preservation Act, or in the aid of the Revenue.

His Excellency also declares, that the said Non-Commissioned Officers and Private Men, who upon examination shall be found fit for Service, shall receive the Sum of One Shilling and Sixpence per Diem each, from the time of their leaving their respective Post Towns, until their arrival at the examining Station, calculating the same at the rate of Ten Miles for a Day's March, and shall be afterwards subsisted until attached to a Regiment, at the following rates; namely, Sergeants, at One Shilling and Ten pence, and Corporals and Privates, at One Shilling per Diem each, together with the usual Allowance of One Penny per Diem for Beer Money.

His Excellency further declares, that every Man found fit for duty, shall, on his joining the Regiment to which he shall be appointed, receive a Bounty of One Pound Five Shillings, or so much thereof as shall remain after supplying him with proper Necessaries; and that every Man, when discharged, shall be allowed to reckon his Service in such Regiment in addition to his former Service, and to receive such an increased rate of Pension, as the entire period of his Service may entitle him to claim under the Regulations now in force. And also, that the Men who, upon examination shall be found *unfit for any Duty*, shall be dismissed, and be settled with at the rate of One Shilling and Sixpence per Diem each, from the time of their leaving their respective Post Towns, until their arrival at the examining Stations, calculating at the rate of Ten Miles for a Day's March, and shall receive also the like Allowance to carry them back to their homes; and that while detained for examination, they shall receive the same Pay and Allowances as the Men found fit for Duty.

Every Out-Pensioner appearing for Examination is hereby required to produce to the examining Officer at the Station his Instruction Paper.

If any Out-Pensioners who are exempted from the present Call as aforesaid, except Persons employed in the Police Establishments of Dublin, or of the respective Counties, or in Aid of the Revenue, as aforesaid, shall nevertheless be desirous of Volunteering their Services, and shall present themselves for Examination at any of the Places of Assembling, they shall, if found fit to serve, be attached to a Regiment with the same Bounty, Pay, and Allowances as the Men who are included in the Call.

Should any of the Regiments to which Out-Pensioners may be attached in pursuance of this Proclamation, be ordered on Foreign Service, the Out-Pensioners so attached will be transferred to other Corps serving within the United Kingdom.

And it is hereby notified, that all the Out-Pensioners hereby called upon to attend, who shall not appear at any of the Times and Places herein appointed, will be struck off the Books of the Out-Pension of the said Hospitals respectively, according to the Regulations under which such Pension is granted, without any prospect of being restored thereto.
