

By the Lord Lieutenant General and General
Governor of Ireland,

A PROCLAMATION.

WELLESLEY.

WHEREAS by an Act, passed in the
last Session of Parliament, "to pre-
vent the further Circulation of Tokens issued
by the Governor and Company of the Bank of
Ireland, for the convenience of the Public,
and for defraying the Expense of exchanging
such Tokens," it is enacted, That from and
after the Fifth day of January, One thousand
eight hundred and twenty-six, the said Tokens
shall no longer pass or circulate, or be
received in Payment or Exchange, or other-
wise howsoever, nor shall the said Governor
and Company of the Bank of Ireland, from and
after the said Fifth day of January, One thou-
sand eight hundred and twenty-six, be in any
manner liable, or compellable to pay the value
of any such Tokens or Token to the Holder
thereof.

And whereas in order to enable His Majesty's
Subjects in Ireland more easily to exchange the
Bank Tokens described in the said Act,
for the Silver Coin of the Realm, We have
thought fit to direct that certain days
should be appointed in each of the principal
Towns of the Provinces in Ireland, on which
persons bringing in the Bank Tokens to the
Officers duly appointed to receive the same,
may receive in Exchange the Silver Coin of the
Realm.

And whereas Directions have been given
for carrying the said Arrangements into effect
in the Province of Ulster and Connaught, and
in the Counties of Longford and Louth, and it
has appeared to Us advisable that the same
should next be carried into effect in the County
of Westmeath, the King's County, and Part of
the County of Tipperary, and in the County of
Cork: We do hereby name and appoint the
Twentieth day of October instant, as the day
on which, and from thence until the Thirty first
day of October then next ensuing, as the period

in the County of Westmeath, and the Twenty third day of October instant, as the day on which and from thence until the Fourth day of November, then next ensuing, as the Period in the King's County, and the Sixteenth day of October instant, as the day on which, and from thence until the Twenty-seventh day of October, then next ensuing, as the Period in the County of Tipperary, and the Twentieth day of October instant, as day on which, and from thence until the Fourth day of November, then next ensuing, as the Period in the County of Cork, during which any person or persons may attend and deliver to the Officers appointed to exchange the same, at the under-mentioned Places in the said Counties respectively, any Silver Tokens of the Bank of Ireland as aforesaid, and may receive in lieu thereof Silver Coin of the Realm, at the nominal value of the said Tokens and Coin respectively.
