CORPORATION OF CORK.

BYE-LAWS

For regulating Hackney Carriages, made by the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Borough of Cork, under the Common Seal of the Borough, on the 23rd day of October, 1854.

GENERAL LICENSING DAY OF HACKNEY CARRIAGES.

No. 1. The 1st day of January in every year, if the same be not on Sunday, and if the same day shall in any year be on Sunday, then the second day of January in such year, shall be the general licensing day of all hackney curringes plying for hire within 5 miles from the General Post Office of the City of Cork; and for every such licence there shall be paid to the Town Clerk the sum of two shillings and six pence.

REQUISITION FOR LICENCE OF A HACKNEY CARRIAGE.

No. 2. The requisition for any such licence shall be in the form or to the effect following :

To the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Borough of Cork.

I of require a licence to ply for hire within 5 miles from the General Post-Office of the City of Cork, a hackney carriage, and that I or (and of are the proprietors of such carriage, and concerned in partnership with the said) am the proprietor of such carriage and concerned solely in the keeping, employing, or letting to hire of such carriage.
