WHEREAS His Majesty has been graciously pleased, by Warrant under His Royal Signet and Sign Manual, dated at Carlton-house, the 20th Day of December, 1821, to give and grant to John Smith Barry, of Foaty, in the County of Cork, Esq. to his Brother James Smith Barry, Esq. and to his Sisters Caroline-Augusta, Narcissa and Louisa, His Royal Licence and Authority that they, and each of them, and their Issue respectively, and the respective Husbands and Issue of the said Females, may take and use the Surnames of Smith and Barry, and also use and bear the Arms of Smith and Barry quarterly; (the said Royal Licence and Authority, as far as regards the said Females, their Husbands and their Issue, to take effect only in case of their respective Succession to certain Property expressed and limited in the last Will and Testament of James Hugh Smith Barry, late of Foaty, in the County of Cork aforesaid, and of Marberry-Hall, in the County Palatine of Chester, Esq. deceased); provided that such His Majesty's Concession and Royal Declaration be first recorded, and the Arms duly exemplified, in the Office of Ulster King of Arms of all Ireland, otherwise the said Royal Licence and Authority to be void and of none Effect: Now, these are to certify and declare, that the same have been recorded and exemplified accordingly.
