

# OFFICE OF ARMS,

*14th April, 1824.*

**W**HEREAS His Majesty has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto the Reverend Alexander Chetwood Hamilton, of Thomastown, in the County of Kilkenny, Clerk, His Royal Licence and Permission that he and his Issue may take and use the Surname of Stubber, instead of that of Hamilton; and also use and bear the Armorial Ensigns of Stubber only; provided that such His Majesty's concession and Royal declaration be first recorded and the arms duly exemplified in the office of Ulster King of Arms of all Ireland, otherwise the said Royal Licence and Authority to be void and of none effect: Now, these are to certify and declare, that the same have been recorded and exemplified accordingly.
