HEREAS the King has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto James Meara, of the City of Dublin, Esq. Captain in His Majesty's Navy, His Royal Licence and Permission that he and his Issue may take and use the Surname and bear the Armorial Ensigns of Kean, in lieu of those of Meara; provided that such His Majesty's Concession be first recorded and the Arms duly exemplified in the Office of Ulster King of Arms, otherwise the said Royal Licence and Authority to be void and of none effect;—Now, these are to certify and declare, that the same have been recorded and exemplified accordingly.
