Barrister at Law, His Royal Licence and Permission that he and his Issue may take and use the Surname of Bond, in addition to and after that of M'Geough, and also bear the Arms of Bond in addition to and quarterly with those of M'Geough; provided that such His Majesty's Concession be first recorded and the Arms duly exemplified in the Office of Ulster King of Arms of all Ireland, otherwise the said Royal Licence and Authority to be void and of none effect: Now, these are to declare and certify, that the same have been recorded and certified accordingly.
