**W**HEREAS the King has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto Robert Bomford, of Mount-Jessop, in the County of Longford, Esq. His Royal Licence and Permission that he and his Issue may take and use the Surname and bear the Armorial Ensigns of Jessop, in lieu of the Surname and Arms of Bomford; provided that such His Majesty's Concession be recorded and the Arms duly exemplified in the Office of Ulster King of Arms of all Ireland, otherwise the said Royal Licence and Authority to be void and of none effect:—  
Now, these are to declare and certify, that the same have been recorded and exemplified accordingly.
