

Ulster's Office, May 19, 1826.

WHEREAS His Majesty has been graciously pleased to give and grant unto George Gun, of Riversdale, in the County of Kerry, Esq. and unto Jane his Wife, one of the Daughters and Co-heirs of Robert Gordon, late of New Grove, in the County of Cork, Esq. deceased, by Anne his Wife, Niece of the Right Honourable Robert late Baron Rossmore, of the Kingdom of Ireland, also deceased, that they and their issue may, in compliance with an injunction contained in the last Will and Testament of the said Lord Rossmore, take and use the Surname of Cuninghame in addition to and after that of Gun, and likewise use and bear the Armorial Ensigns of Cuninghame, in addition to and quartered with those of Gun, according to the usage and laws of Arms ; provided that such His Majesty's concession be first recorded, and the Arms duly exemplified in the Office of Ulster King of Arms of all Ireland, otherwise the said Royal Licence and Authority to be void and of none effect : now, these are to declare and certify, that the same have been recorded and exemplified accordingly.
