

# ULSTER'S OFFICE,

*February 15, 1830.*

**W**HEREAS the King has been graciously pleased, by licence under His Majesty's royal signet and sign manuel, to give and grant unto George Francis Pomeroy, of Rathangan, in the County of Kildare, Esq. His royal permission and authority, that he and his issue may, in compliance with an injunction contained in the last will and testament of his uncle, the Right Honourable Henry, late Lord Viscount Harberton, deceased, take and use the surname of Colley only, and likewise use and bear the armorial ensigns of Colley only; provided that such, His Majesty's concession and royal declaration be first recorded, and the arms duly

exemplified in the Office of Ulster, King of Arms of all Ireland, otherwise the said royal licence and authority to be void and of none effect.

Now, these are to declare and certify that the same have been recorded and exemplified accordingly.
