WHEREAS the King has been graciously pleased, by licence under His Majesty's royal signet and sign manual, to give and grant unto Harvey Pratt, Esq. second surviving son of the Rev. Joseph Pratt, late of Catragh Castle, in the County of Cavan, Clerk, deceased, by Sarah, his wife, also deceased. who was one of the daughters of the Right Honourable Hervey late Lord Viscount Mountmorres, also deceased, His royal permission and authority that he and his issue may take, use, and bear the surname and arms of De Montmorency in lieu of those of Pratt, provided that such His Majesty's royal concession be recorded, and the arms duly exemplified in the Office of Ulster King of Arms of all Ireland, otherwise the said royal license and authority to be void and of none effect; now these are to declare and certify that the same have been recorded and exemplified accordingly.
