HE Queen has been graciously pleased, by license under the Royal Signet and Sign Manual, to give and grant to the Right Honourable Thomas Townsend Aremberg Mullins, Lord Baron Ventry, of Burnhem House, in the County of Kerry, Her Majesty's royal license and authority, that he and the descendants of his Grandfather, Thomas, the first Baron Ventry, may reassume their ancient sirname, and call themselves and be called De Moleyns, provided such Her Majesty's royal concession and declaration be recorded in the Office of Ulster King of Arms of all Ireland, that the Officers of Arms there, and all others, upon occasion may take full notice and have knowledge thereof.
